Please read carefully.

- Must be a Senior at J. Frank Dobie High School and a member of the Dobie HS tennis team.
- Must submit this application and all forms associated with the scholarship to the scholarship committee for review.
- Open to J. Frank Dobie High School seniors tennis players planning to attend college, either a 2 year or 4 year institution.
- Must demonstrate good sportsmen-like conduct on and off the courts, willingness to help fellow players on and off the courts, take the initiative to be a leader on and off the courts, demonstrate courage and dignity while representing their family and Dobie HS at tournaments (not limited to school tournaments), and display the heart of a true champion on and off the courts.
- Must have good grades in school (A, B and C's) and must submit an official transcript of grades.
- Must have at least 20 hours of volunteer hours (school, church, community). Please submit proof of Volunteer Hours, and ensure hours are verified with adult signature or initials. **Hours are only valid from June 1, 2018 through March 29, 2019.** You may use your own form or the provided by the D. Lajaunie Tennis Scholarship web site at www.DLtennisscholarships.com.
- Must write an essay of 250 words or more, "Why I deserve this scholarship".
- Must have a recommendation from 1 teacher and 1 high school tennis coach. Recommendation forms are available in the "College Now" office at school or on the Darren Lajaunie Tennis Scholarship web site at: www.DLtennisscholarships.com. Recommendations must be submitted to Denice Smajstrla by end of school day, March 29, 2019. A parent and/or student may not submit the recommendation forms.
- The scholarship check will be made out and sent to the college of the attending student to be put towards tuition. The recipient will receive a copy of the letter sent to college or university on application.
- Applicant must submit this completed application, completed checklist, submit completed volunteer form, submit an official transcript of grades, recommendation forms and any additional pages in a sealed envelope to Denice Smajstrla. 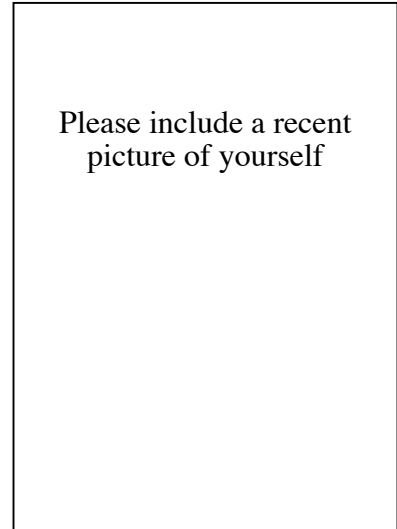
