Darren was a devoted husband and father. He was a dedicated engineer for Lockheed Martin at the Johnson Space Center with a compelling passion for the game of tennis.

Darren began his tennis career playing tennis at J. Frank Dobie High School in Houston and graduated Co-Valedictorian in 1984. At the University of Texas Tennis Club, Darren won the 1988 Spring Open Champion Men's "B" Singles title. At a local Houston tennis club, Darren was the Men's 3.5 Singles Champion July 2010, and Men's 4.0 Singles Champion in August, 2010. In September, he was a Finalist in the Men's 4.5 Singles Championship game. Darren graduated from UT with a degree in Electrical Engineering in 1988.

Darren was diagnosed with Melanoma cancer in October 2009 and while enduring many clinical trials and chemo treatments, continued to play tennis and worked until his death in May 2011. Darren was the epitome of leadership, sportsmanship, courage, dignity, strength and had the heart of a true tennis champion.

The applicant will be evaluated on the basis of academic abilities, character, and service demonstrated to his/her school and community; in addition to the aforementioned qualities that Darren Lajaunie exhibited in his lifetime
