Applicants, Please read carefully.

- A one time college scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to 1 girl and 1 boy from the Dobie HS Tennis Team who submits a completed application package. If there is only one recipient for either category, and they do not receive a full \$1,000, it is because their package is incomplete.
- Must be a Senior at J. Frank Dobie High School and an active member of the Dobie HS tennis team in good standing, planning to attend college, either a 2 or 4 year institution.
- Applicant must complete and submit the Application in ink, Checklist, Recent photo, a 250 word Essay and an official transcript of Grades to the scholarship committee for review. Please carefully read & follow all the requirements for this application. If your essay is less than 250 words your application will not be reviewed or accepted. All forms are to be submitted either to Ms. Solis in P16 or emailed to: cjlajaunie@gmail.com by Thursday, March 24, 2022.
- There will be NO Community Service Hours required this year.
- There will be NO Teacher OR Coach Recommendations required this year.
- Must demonstrate good sportsmen-like conduct on and off the courts, willingness to help fellow players on and off the courts, take the initiative to be a leader on and off the courts, demonstrate courage and dignity while representing their family and Dobie HS at tournaments (not limited to school tournaments), and display the heart of a true champion on and off the courts.
- The scholarship check will be sent directly to the college of the attending student to be put towards tuition. The recipient will receive a copy of the letter & check that is sent to the college or university on application.

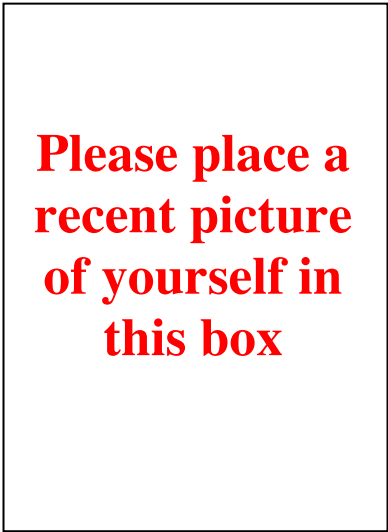
